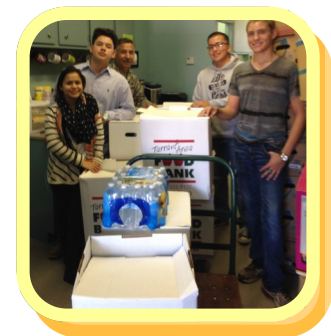

## What is WestAid

WestAid is a regional food pantry serving one of the most culturally, diverse areas of Southwest Tarrant County. WestAid is the only five day a week pantry on Fort Worth's west side. Families who contact WestAid are in a situation where basic expenses are often equal to or more than income. This is often due to long-term public assistance, aged on very limited income, persons who are disabled, short-termed reduced income, families experiencing first time financial crises and the general category of being under-employed.
